At KARM, we believe when rescue is combined with strong supportive relationships that reflect the heart of Jesus, true restoration can occur. Those who were once struggling to break free from addiction, homelessness and other challenges can experience renewal and rebirth. Every day, we see people restored to God, our community, their families... and themselves.

RESCUE SERVICES

- **Emergency Services** provide basic needs – food, shelter and safety – to the nearly 5,000 women and men each year who turn to us in their time of crisis.
- **KARM Care** offers space for our community partners to provide primary medical care to address physical and mental health needs, Respite Care for men who have been discharged from the hospital and other resources and referrals.
- Our **Outreach Team** visits homeless camps around the area – providing necessities, praying and showing God's love to those who choose to live on the streets.



RELATIONSHIPS

- Our **LaunchPoint** four-week program helps students discover God's plan and purpose for their lives and offers a variety of life skills training and community resources.
- KARM'S **Berea** 9-12 month program teaches and instills four values in every participant: the dignity of work, the value of learning, the spirit of serving and the joy of living.
- **Serenity Ministries** offers an 18-month biblically-based residential program for women (and children) in a beautiful, secure environment so they can learn how deeply loved by God they are.
- **KARM Works** helps guests find meaningful, sustainable employment by providing biblically-based job skills training and employment placement assistance.
