

Growing up, it was just Arlayna and her mom.
They were best friends. Arlayna told her mom everything – except that she was being abused by the cousin who babysat her. It started when Arlayna was just 3 years old, and it set the tone for the next several decades of her life.

"I grew up feeling like a monster. I never got along with people my age or had healthy friendships. It was embarrassing."

Arlayna began using drugs and alcohol at a young age to block out her pain. Because of her past, she didn't know the difference between a platonic relationship and a romantic one. She began looking for love in the wrong places, which led to more abuse. She got pregnant at age 15.

"My mom took me to have an abortion," Arlayna says. "I don't blame her for that. She was doing her best. But that is when my addiction really started."

Arlayna tried several times to get her life back on track. After being homeless for several months, she hit rock bottom when a man she was staying with attacked her. She realized she had to change her life to stay alive, so she came to Knox Area Rescue Ministries.

Arlayna joined our Serenity Ministries program and started building her self-worth through Serenity, Bible studies and classes. She had always believed in God, but through our ministry she built a relationship with Him – which helped her heal from the years of trauma and abuse she had endured.
