I thank God for how YOU are providing hope, help and healing to people who are hurting in our community.



Renny grew up knowing about God. His grandmother took him to church. But he knew about death and loss from a young age too. Several people in his life died from suicide or addiction – leaving Kenny feeling abandoned. He started self-medicating his grief with drugs, which led to an addiction that prevented him from being able to hold a job as an adult. Unable to support himself, Kenny began experiencing homelessness.

"I slept on friends' couches, but also sometimes underneath bridges, on sidewalks or in the woods – just in random spots I thought were secure. I was involved in illegal activities to make money to support my habit."

Kenny's life took an unexpected turn when a life-threatening overdose put him in the hospital. While receiving treatment, officials realized his legal trouble, and he was sent to jail when he was discharged. However, incarceration ended up being a blessing in disguise.

"It gave me a lot of time to think. I realized God put me in this situation to see His presence in my life."

Upon his release, Kenny came to KARM and joined our New Life program. Through Christ-centered counseling and life-planning classes, he is overcoming his addiction and addressing his past trauma. His self-esteem and motivation to give back to his community in positive, meaningful ways are growing.

"KARM invested so much time and effort in my recovery. They are helping me – a former addict – get my life together. That means more than anything to me. It's priceless."

This fall, Kenny gives thanks for YOU and your incredible generosity. Your prayers and support have helped change his life. "To anyone who is struggling with addiction, I say, 'Don't give up.' I almost gave away one of the most precious gifts given to me: a relationship with Jesus Christ. Thanks to KARM, my life was saved."


