Aria's mother abandoned her when she was a newborn. Her father did his best to raise her, but Maria grew up believing she wasn't worthy of love. "I started looking for acceptance in other avenues, like relationships and friends. I struggled to figure out who I was... my identity," she says. "My lack of self awareness plus the trauma of my childhood led me to struggle with addiction."

After years of trying to fill the void in her life in unhealthy ways, Maria knew she had to change. She initially sought help from a short-term treatment facility, but **after realizing she needed long-term help, she came to Serenity Ministries.** It was just what she'd been looking for to satisfy her spiritual longing for a relationship with the Lord. "I grew up knowing about Christ, but I felt there was something more... I just didn't know how to obtain it," she says.

In our program, Maria found an environment of love and support that gave her time and space to work through the uncertainty in her life. "I'd never been in such a close-knit community," she says. "They were willing to just listen and allow me to feel what I hadn't been able to feel for such a long time. That was different for me."

Today, Maria has a job while going back to school. She is excited about her new life. Most importantly, she has found her identity and self-worth. "Cultivating my relationship with the Lord truly opened my eyes to who I am and whose I am. It's made a world of a difference," she says. "I know I have worth, and that feels so good."


A Season of Growth...

Outreach Ministry: Standing in their private hell...



Pastor Mychal knows what it's like to live on the streets. He struggled with addiction and homelessness for years. Now, as the leader of KARM's Outreach Team, he uses his own experience to reach our homeless neighbors with love and compassion.

"I understand what it's like to be beat down to the point of self-destruction," Pastor Mychal says. "So I go out and stand with people in their homelessness. Because if you descend into somebody else's private

hell and stand with them, it ceases to be hell."

Each week, Pastor Mychal and the outreach team reach almost 200 people who live on the streets. The team can build trust with people who are unsure about accepting help. The focus of their work is being consistent in building relationships.

"Whether it's 25 degrees below zero or a 116 degree heat index, we show up," Pastor Mychal says. As physically and emotionally challenging as it is, there is no other work he would rather be doing. His favorite part of the job is sitting on a little stool and reading the Bible to people in the homeless camps.

"We cry and hurt and figure out life together," he says. "There is such guilt and shame associated with their darkness. Getting to speak a glimmer of light into their life has been one of the best things of my 37 years of ministry."
